Anyone/group using the church for activities during the week, is asked to adhere to the following. If you have any questions, please contact the church office.

- Any area/surfaces used/touched (including chairs, sofa's, microphones, etc.) must be cleaned with a sanitizing/disinfectant cleaner.
- The church is to be notified if your group will be over 30 participants.
- The use of the kitchen area is discouraged, but if used for any reason, your group is responsible for the complete cleaning of all surfaces with a sanitizing/disinfectant cleaner, no dishes/silverware may be left in sinks or drains to dry. If using the ice machine, please wipe the doors after use.
- Please bring all supplies needed, i.e., sanitizing/disinfectant cleaner, paper towels, ice, cups, plates, etc.
- Vacuuming or mopping of carpets/floors is not required for normal use unless there is a spill.
- When leaving, please place all tables and chairs as they were when you arrived.
- Please use only the scheduled room for your group. Each group is scheduled one room per event unless approved by the church office.
- Please leave the sign-in sheet in your scheduled room and a member of the church staff will pick them up.
- Please make sure any pamphlets, flyers, trash, etc. are removed.
- All groups are responsible for setting up tables/chairs etc., for your group meeting unless
- otherwise requested directly to the church office.
- All groups are responsible for locking the exterior doors and turning off all lights when leaving.
- For the safety of everyone, we always encourage you to keep the doors locked.

Tips for How to Stay Safe and Keep Others Safe When in Grace Presbyterian Church

Please note that you are attending worship at your own risk for sickness.

Please wear a mask when in the church.

Do not touch anyone and only touch what you absolutely must touch.

Please refrain from wandering to other parts of the church (such as Bell Hall) other than to the restroom currently.

Please note that greeters before and after worship may be limited during this time, but if you need assistance, you may see any Elder.

Be sure to pick up a bulletin or any other items needed for worship from the tables outside the Narthex prior to worship and read it for changes in our typical worship service.

Stay at least six feet away from people not in your immediate family.

Please allow at least two (2) empty pews between you and other congregants or sit at the opposite ends of a pew so no one has to sit alone. Feel free to sit anywhere in the pews in the sanctuary, including the balcony, as long as you are maintaining a safe distance from one another.

All singing will be done by the worship leaders until further notice.

Please allow others to come and leave on their own to not crowd the doorways or aisles.

Please drop your offering in the offering plate as you leave the sanctuary, not before or during worship.

Please note there is no children's church during this time.

Your Session has called a Congregational Meeting immediately following worship on September 6, 2020 in the Sanctuary of Grace Presbyterian Church for the purpose of hearing and acting upon a recommendation to reduce the current Session size from ten members to nine members to allow our Session to function in three equal size classes of three members each. Only members of Grace Presbyterian Church present in the sanctuary at the time of the congregation meeting will have vote for this meeting although all present are allowed voice.

GRACE CARES

The Grace Cares Food Pantry took a break in April 2020 to adapt to the New Normal. In the next 90 days, we made many changes, many which have been helpful to both volunteers and clients. We have a new system of packing bags, use our drive through for distribution, and have streamlined our required paperwork. It's true: Necessity is the Mother of Invention!

In the ninety-day period of May, June, and July, we passed out groceries to 1682 individuals, with 580 of those over 60. About one third of our clients come more than once a month.

Our Financial Ministry will begin again after Labor Day. Initially we will work on a referral basis from Bay County Council on Aging to assist with Water Bills, as there should be access to funds for electric bills but not water bills. Donations of any sort are always welcome! We are particularly in need of GREEN BEANS! But are happy to have anything you bring us, including toilet paper.


Christian Education
